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NJ TRANSIT is taking proactive steps to curtail costs while striving to provide high quality service to our train, bus and light rail customers. We have found that many of our customers are now relying on the internet to obtain schedule information, reducing the need for some of our printed timetables. Going forward, NJ TRANSIT will no longer automatically send schedules to individuals, employers, hotels and entertainment venues and businesses. However, we will continue to have printed schedules available at our major rail stations, bus terminals and light rail stations, as well as on board our buses.

We know that access to current bus, train and light rail schedule information is important to our customers. Therefore, we suggest that constituent inquiries be directed to our website: [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com). The website provides the best way to get up-to-date commuter information including complete timetables and a printer-friendly trip planning feature. The local library can be an excellent resource for those without internet access at home or work.
